

Downs UMC, Timber-lee Registration Forms 2026

The high school students at Downs United Methodist Church are attending WinterXtreme at Timber-lee Ministries on Friday January 2nd, 2026. We will leave DUMC around 3:30 on Friday and return around 4:00 on Sunday, January 4th.

We have taken students for the past 20+ years! Each year the students are challenged to know God and follow Him during four large group sessions with music and a speaker, small group times with just our group, and individual conversations with leaders and other students. To register your student a **\$100 non-refundable deposit** made payable to Downs UMC should be sent or dropped off at the Downs UMC office by **Wednesday, December 10th** with all of the forms. The total cost will be \$300. The students will also need to take extra money to cover the cost for dinner on Friday night, snacks, t-shirts, etc.

This year we are implementing a fundraising opportunity to help pay for the cost of a bus up to camp. Students should plan to assist with this fundraiser in person or provide baked goods for a silent auction that morning.

1. **Baked Potato Bar & Dessert Silent Auction Fundraiser – Sunday, December 14th from 10:30am to 12:00pm (immediately following worship).**
2. **If your student is unavailable to participate or provide a dessert, a \$50 additional payment (donation) can be made as part of your registration payment in place of the required fundraiser.**

We have **50** spots available for students. Spots are filled on a- first come, first served basis – but priority will be given to students who have attended Youth Group this school year. The deadline is **December 10th 2025**. Scholarships are available for students who have financial need – please reach out to Kyle with requests on this as soon as possible.

If more than 50 students show interest we will have a waiting list available – the waiting list will act as our backups in case we have students who are unable to attend the trip, or if the Camp has additional slots available for us to bring more students.
